


# **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

In C4B, "Circular Bio-Based Business models to create high-value Bio-based products in integrated value chains" funded by the EU Horizon Europe programme (GA 101135323), a multidisciplinary consortium formed by 11 partners representing 6 EU countries and coordinated by CIAOTECH Srl (IT), will collaborate hand in hand for 4 years to create business models designed to balance the share of power and profits across novel bio-based value chains and to enhance the cooperation among farmers, foresters and industry.



On the one hand, C4B is committed to delivering a holistic analysis of different EU case studies spanning from technology, business behavior, producers' contractual environment, primary agreements and ownership, and sustainability to support rural communities thrive in Europe. On the other hand, through the organization of Open Call, up to 8 projects will be selected to test the applicability, scalability and replicability of the C4B business models demonstrating the plasticity of these new models in different geographical and socio-economic scenarios.
