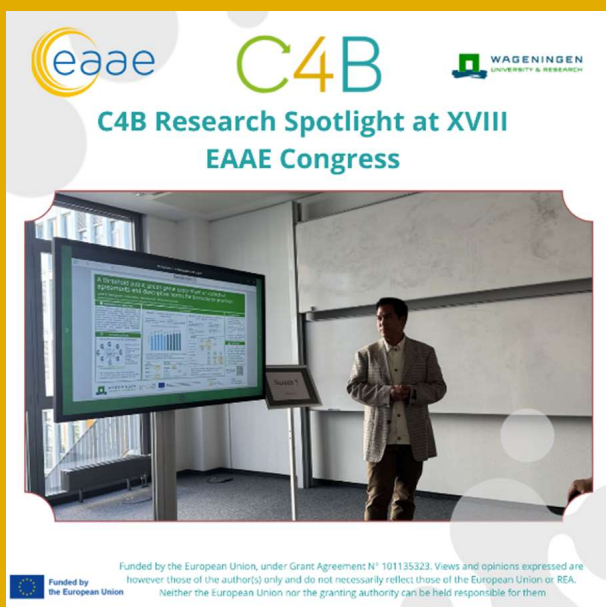


The Envigas Supply Chain Attracts Global Interest


